<i>Health care</i>	3.7%
<i>Higher education</i>	2.0%
<i>Highway and road construction/maintenance</i>	0.2%
<i>Housing (affordability/quality)</i>	0.2%
<i>Job lost/threatened</i>	10.0%
<i>Local economy</i>	1.2%
<i>Mental health care</i>	0.7%
<i>Social services (generally)</i>	3.2%
<i>Utility assistance program cuts (home heat, air, etc)</i>	1.0%
<i>Other</i>	3.0%
<i>Don't know/no answer</i>	5.5%
<b>Not affected by the budget stalemate</b>	<b>56.6%</b>
<b>Don't know if affected by the budget stalemate</b>	<b>6.0%</b>
